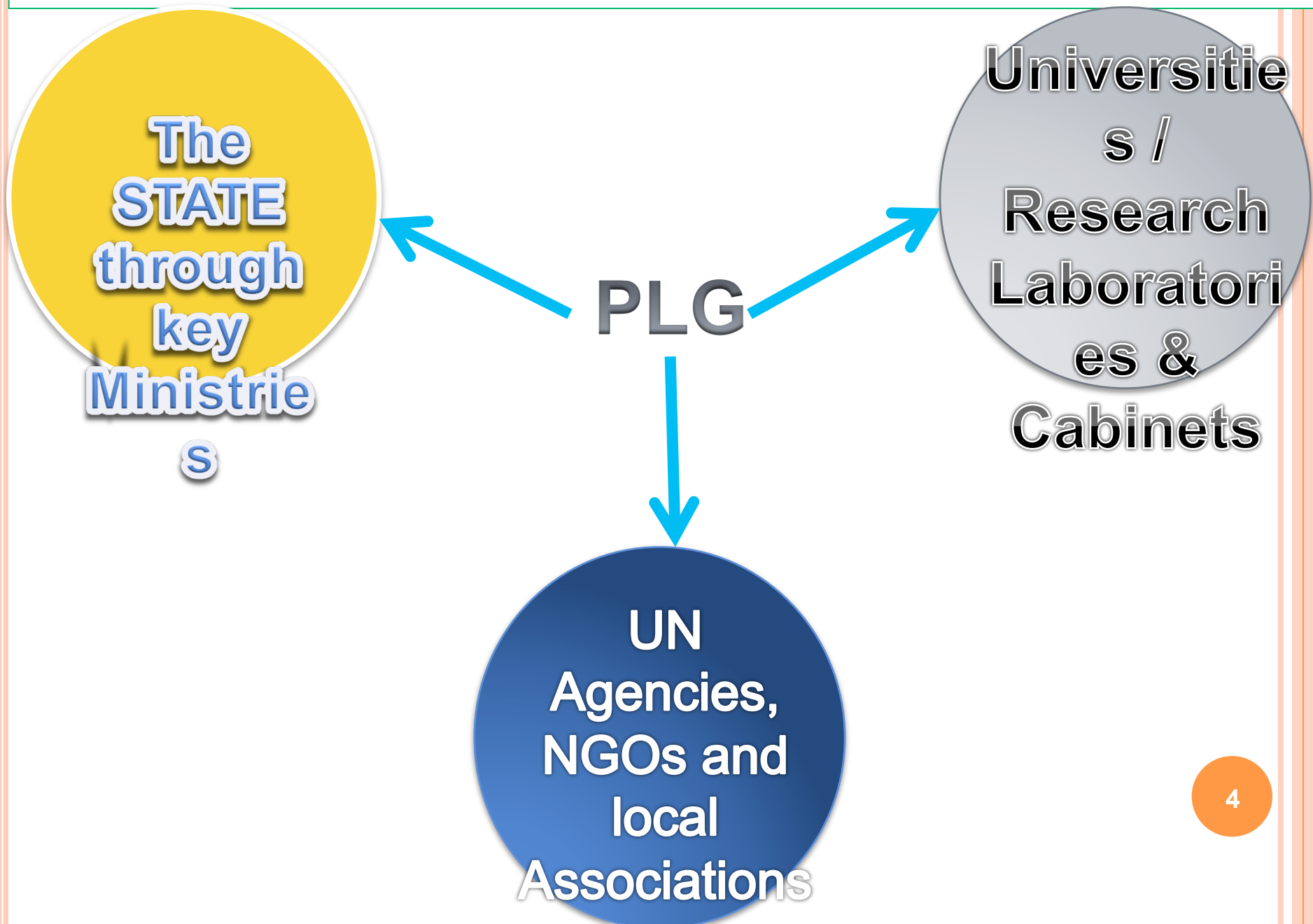
I. Briefly

- ❖ The PLG of Burkina Faso was officially launched in October 2013
- ❖ It is hosted by the Fondation Terre des hommes Lausanne (Delegation of Burkina Faso)
- ❖ Its establishment was facilitated by the local CPWG
- ❖ It currently has about 80 affiliated actors (institutions and individuals)
- ❖ It's the only PLG in a francophone area
- ❖ Since 2014, six researchs have been conducted with methodological support of our Scientific advisory Committee
- ❖ From January 2017, the PLG will be officially transferred to the **Institut Supérieur des Sciences de la Population (University of Ouaga 01 Professeur Joseph Ki-Zerbo)**

The mission assigned to our PLG by its members is to
“Contribute effectively to production and knowledge management as well as developing the skills needed to improve policies and practices concerning the children welfare in Burkina Faso”.
